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SAMPLE DAY

Children are divided into two age groups. Grades K-2nd and grades 3rd-6th are rotated between activities. The estimated time will vary between younger and older students and during days of bad weather.

2:45 Williams K-3rd grade students go to cafeteria when school is out. Attendance is taken, snacks are served and they begin daily activities.

3:00 Folsom K-3rd students, Lynch 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students, arrive at Williams after boarding the Learn and Play bus from their school. (Attendance is taken before students board the bus.)

3:00-3 :20 Folsom and Lynch students are served snacks before they join Williams students.

3:20-3 :25 Announcements
(Super Studens, Affirmation Statement, and Daily Activities)

3:25- 5:30 The K-2 student groups alternates with the 3-6 student groups for the following. (Homework may also be done during this time.)

- Outdoor Play
- Indoor Centers/Activity of the day/Art Center
- Gym Time (Organized Games and Free Play)
- Art: art centers, simple crafts, and painting projects
- Indoor Centers:
 - S.T.E.M.(Science, Technology, Engineering, Math), materials for fine and gross motor skills, social and intellectual development; books and puzzles, pattern blocks, Legos, Lincoln logs, and snap cubes, animal centers, transportation centers, board games, and dramatic play
